- A. My wife wrote and told me that there were only 4 houses on 4 rows in HIN Village, HPD,China.
- Q. Did your wife tell you which direction that village faced, and where the head is located?
- A. Yes, she told me that the village faced the south, and that the head is to the west.
- Q. How many houses in HIN Village do you own?
- A. Only one house.
- Q. Where is that house located?
- A. My wife wrote and told me that our house was located on the 1st lot, 1st row from the head in HIN Village.
- Q. Did your wife write you a descriptionof your house in HIN Village, HPD, China?
- A. My wife wrote and told me that the house was built of burnt brick. She did not say how many rooms were in it.
- Q. When did your wife and tell you that?
- A. After she moved into that house.
- Q. Why should your wife write and tell you what the house was built of and nottell you how many rooms were in the house?
- A. I don't know why.
- Q. Didn't youthink it rather peculiar that your wife wrote and told you what the house was built of and not tell you how many rooms were in that house?
- A. I don't know why - she should have told me how manyrooms were in it.
- Q. Isn't x it a fact that your wife never wrote you any such letter at all telling you about any such housein HIN Village, HPD, China?
- A. Yes, she wrote me a letter telling me that thehouse was built of burnt brick, and that the house is located on the 1st lot, 1st row from the west.
- Q. Did your wife ever write to you telling you that any alterations had been made in the construction of thathouse in HIN Village?
- A. No.
- Q. Are houses in Ching/built of anything else but burnt brick?
- A. Yes, some houses are built of concrete; some houses are built of clay; and some of stone.
- Q. Can you give any reason why the applicant and you should disagree as to what your house in HIN Village, HPD, China, is built of?
- A. I don't know why - I can't explain it.
