

△ Facilities that release, discharge, transfer, incinerate, and/or inject toxic chemicals into the air, water, or land.
 * Superfund sites are abandoned toxic waste sites listed on the EPA's National Priority List (NPL). The soils, surface water, and/or groundwater on these sites are contaminated by toxins.
 □ Solid Waste Landfills Note that the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality considers commercial and municipal waste facilities to be one and the same.
 ○ Municipal Waterworks represent intake sites where cities and towns take water from the river.

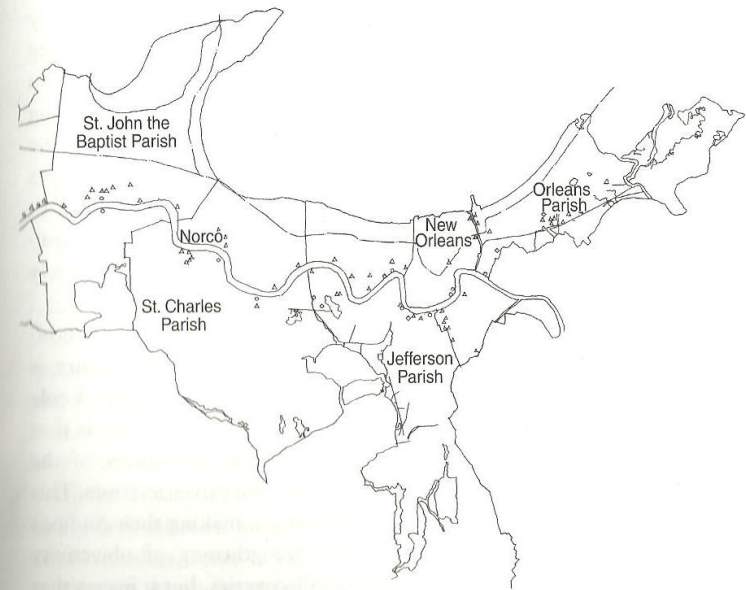
